Inspection and Maintenance Program

Storm Drain System Cleaning:

- a) Campton Township’s Operation and Maintenance Program for MS4: Road –side swales are cleared of debris and garbage once a week.
- b) Catch basins and storm inlets in the Campton Township Highway Department facility are inspected and cleaned quarterly by staff.
- c) Open areas, green space water ways, inspect for erosion
- d) Material Storage
- e) Proper hazardous waste disposal
- f) Road side ditch maintenance
- g) Vehicle washing

Campton Township has had no projects during the last year therefore we are in compliance with all permit conditions.
